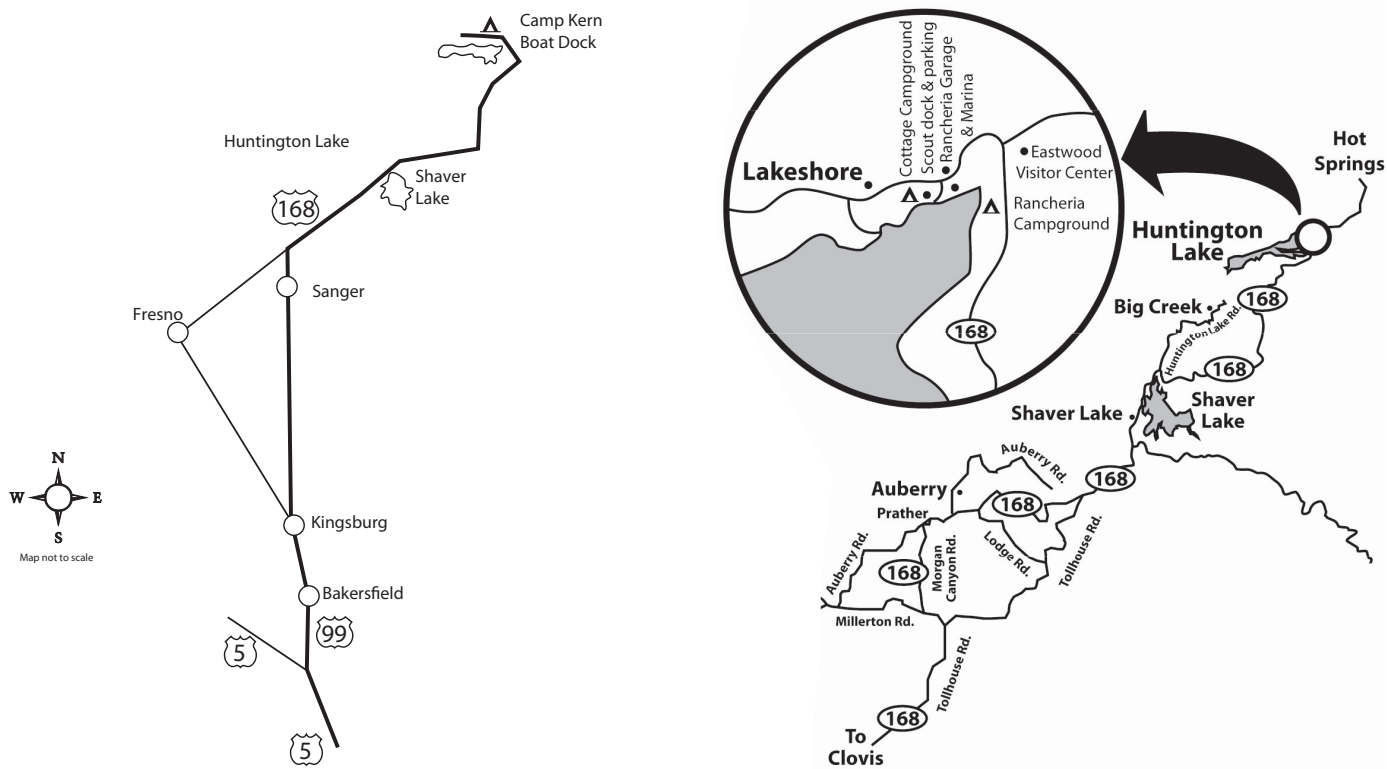


Camp Kern

Huntington Lake, California

Camp Kern is located in the Western Sierra Nevada mountains east of Fresno at an elevation of 7,000 ft.



Camp Kern is reached by taking Interstate 5 to Highway 99 through Bakersfield to Kingsburg. Take the Hwy 201 Sierra Street Exit and turn left on 10th Ave (which becomes Academy). Follow the "Sanger" signs.

It is a good idea to fill your gas tank in Sanger. There are also numerous fast food restaurants to choose from to serve as a rest stop. Stay on Academy through Sanger and continue north to the junction of Highway 168. Turn right on Hwy. 168 and follow the signs to Shaver Lake/Huntington Lake. Continue on the winding road past Shaver Lake to Huntington Lake (about 20 minutes).

Soon there will be a gas station on your right and a marina on your left. Just past this is a left turn onto a dirt road with a sign reading "Camp Kern & Camp Oljato." If you pass the campground on your left, then turn around as you've gone too far.

The parking lot is operated by the Rancheria conglomerate and two Boy Scout camps use the dock at the far end. Go ahead and park near the dock. DO NOT park directly in front of the dock. Please direct your Scouts to unload at a discreet distance from the loading/unloading area until directed by a Staff Host. All troop gear should be kept in a distinct pile neatly away from other troops' gear.
