Silver Beaver Award Nomination Form

As a movement whose leadership is overwhelmingly volunteer, the Boy Scouts of America recognizes the need to acknowledge the invaluable services of adult men and women. Of the hundreds of awards that are presented each year, the Silver Beaver is the highest and most prestigious honor awarded by a local Council. To be considered for this honor in the Southern Sierra Council, a recipient must meet the following criteria:

- Nominee must be a registered Scouter of at least 21 years of age.
- Nominee must have rendered distinguished and noteworthy service to youth. The nature and value of the service to youth may consist of a single plan or decisions that contributed vitally to the lives of a large number of youth, or it may have involved a small number of youth over a period of time.
- Nominee should have contributed some service to youth outside of Scouting.
- Consideration should be given to the nominee's position and the corresponding opportunity to render service beyond expectation of duty.
